Introduction

This privacy notice sets out the way we process your information and describes our privacy and fair processing policy. Information we collect from you

We will collect and process the following categories of data about you:

Information you give us. This is information about you that you give us by filling in forms on the website, interacting with the website or by corresponding with us by phone, email or otherwise. It includes information you provide when you sign up to our newsletter service or make an enquiry about our products and services.

The information you give us will include your name, address, email address and phone number, as well as preliminary information about your requirements in relation to the services which we offer.

Information we collect about you. This is information that we collect automatically about your visit during your time on the website. It typically involves technical information and is often collected using small data files called "cookies". This information helps us to provide you with a good experience when you browse the Site and also to indicate where the Site requires improvement.

Analytics

We use Google Analytics to measure people's experience of our website. This allows us to find out which pages are most popular and which browsers people use, helping us learn how we can improve the experience of visitors to our website.

Uses made of the information

All information about you that we collect or receive, whether of a personal or technical nature, may be used by us in the following ways:

- To carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us and to provide you with the information, products and services that you request from us;
- To provide you with information about other goods and services that we offer that are similar or relevant to those that you have already purchased or enquired about, such contact will only be made by email or phone from which you can opt out at any time;
- To notify you about changes to our services;



- To administer the Site and for internal operations, including troubleshooting, system and security updates, data analysis, testing, research, statistical and survey purposes;
- To improve the Site to ensure that content is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- As part of our efforts to keep the Site safe and secure;
- To comply with our record keeping and information storage obligations and policy (please see the "Where We Store Your Personal Data" section below for more details). Information we receive from other sources. We will combine this information with information you give to us and information we collect about you. We will use this information and the combined information for the purposes set out above (depending on the types of information we receive).

Where we store your personal data

We have secure data systems that can only be accessed by authorised people within the company, all whom have received training on data protection.

How we share data

Personal data collected and processed by us may be shared with the following groups where necessary: contractors, advisors and agents we employ on defined tasks; and employees.

We will only share the data to the extent required to fulfil our obligations to you. We will control the ways in which those working with or for Huckleberry use such data, including how they can access and use it and how long they retain it.

We will not sell or share your personal information or allow any other organisation to use it.

How long do we keep data?

We will keep personal data only for as long as is necessary. We will review the retention of data records on a regular basis to ensure that they remain accurate and relevant. Records will be updated, securely deleted or archived when it is no longer appropriate to keep them.
